

WHAT TO BRING LIST (updated)

The following is a list of clothing and other items that scouts will need to take to camp. **All items (clothing, towels, etc.) must be labeled with the scouts' name.** While in camp, the Scouts will be sleeping on cots. It is important that your son brings with him a **sleeping bag or 2 warm blankets.**

By Bus: Take the Red & Tan Bus (#9A) from 175th St. at Port Authority terminal (G.W. Bridge) to Alpine Scout Camp (approx. \$15.00 roundtrip).

By Car from New York City: Travel to the George Washington Bridge taking the upper level. Take your first exit on your right in New Jersey (Palisades Pkwy. North). Travel for about 9 miles to exit 3 - Alpine approach road. Follow the exit around under the Pkwy. to a traffic light (this will be Route 9W). Make a right hand turn and travel north for about 1-1/4 miles. Alpine Scout Camp will be on your left hand side.

By Car from New Jersey: From southern or mid-New Jersey, you can take either the New Jersey Turnpike or Garden State Pkwy. to Interstate 80. Travel on 80 to the last exit before the George Washington Bridge toll (this will be in Fort Lee). The exit will say Route 9 and Palisades Pkwy. You may then take either Route 9W for 10 miles to Camp Alpine (it will be on your left), or get on to the Palisades Pkwy. and travel for about 9 miles to exit 3 - Alpine approach road. Follow the exit around under the Pkwy. to a traffic light (this will be Route 9W). Make a right hand turn and travel north for about 1-1/4 miles. Alpine Scout Camp will be on your left hand side.

Once You have entered Camp: Follow the road and make the third right leading you toward Reeves Lodge. Continue past the lodge and you will see the John E. Reeves Cub World sign on your left. The Cub World Office is located in the Whitehead Dining Hall building.
